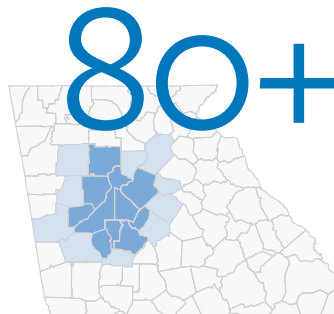
## EVERY DAY PROMOTING BALANCED & RESPONSIBLE GROWTH
